

What is the research?

We are recruiting participants who are parents to adult children with Autism. We are interested in parents experience of their child transitioning into independent living, although parents with adult children still living at home can complete this study too.

Can I participate?

The adult child must be over the age of 18, but parent age does not matter. Any parent of an adult child with Autism can participate.

What do I have to do?

The study involves answering demographic questions and two surveys – it takes around 15 minutes to complete. All answers are anonymous, and you are encouraged to make a unique code in case you wish to remove your data at a later date. The unique code allows your data to be easily identified.
